You should retain all the documents, canceled checks and other data that form the basis of the returns to a taxing authority. You have the final responsibility for the income tax returns and therefore, you should review them carefully before you sign and file them.

## What do you need to bring to do your taxes?

- 1. Form W2 from all employers last year
- 2. SSA-1099 for social security benefits
- 3. 1099 R for withdrawals from a retirement account
- 4. 1099-Misc for payment from people who weren't your employer (i.e. self-employed)
- 5. 1099-K for credit card payments received (selling on eBay, driving for Uber, etc.)
- 6. Form 1099-Int for interest received from banks or stocks
- 7. Form 1099-DIV for any brokerage accounts (i.e. Edwards Jones, TD Ameritrade)
- 8. Mortgage Interest Statements and Property Taxes paid in last year for Itemized Schedule
- 9. Taxpayers & Dependents Social Security Cards
- 10. Rental property Income & Expenses
- 11. Expenses for any self-employed activities for last year
- 12. 1098T for college expenses and out of pocket cost for books and required class items, this includes a computer and software costs.
- 13. Student Loan Interest
- 14. HUD statement if you bought or sold a property last year
- 15. Gambling winnings from the lottery or a casino where you had to give your social security number upon claiming the winnings
- 16. Cancellation of Debt-1099-C, these will be issued if a credit card company or loan company "forgive" any debt you had and no longer hold you liable for the debt.
- 17. Anything that has came in your mail that states this is an IMPORTANT TAX DOCUMENTS, bringing more is far better than not having what we need.
